LinkedIn Outreach: The Art of Networking Requests

Reaching out to someone you don't know is a **normal** part of networking in the U.S.—and easier than you think! Just follow these three steps:

1

Introduce yourself briefly

[Name, School, Area of Interest]

2

Explain your reason for reaching out

[Ex: to learn more about their role, company, or career path]

3

Suggest a short meeting or ask to connect

[Include a timeframe if you're asking to chat]

I have 4+ years of experience in Public Health Research and Initiatives. 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Informational Interviewing: Questions to Ask

Ask about the job, company, industry, or personal career path:

What does a typical week look like in your role?

What do you enjoy most about your work—and what's most challenging?


What types of decisions are you responsible for?

What skills or qualities are most valued in your position or field?

What past job or college experience best prepared you for your current role?

Tip: These questions help you go beyond job descriptions and understand what working in this role is really like.
