NRP PROFESSIONAL DEVELOPMENT AWARD



How much is the award?

• \$100 to \$500

What can the award cover?

- Work-related education and training
- Conferences
- Certificates
- Continuing education
- Classes or seminars
- Similar instructional opportunities not otherwise covered.

Note that this award cannot be used for courses for academic credit and amounts may change in future cycles depending on funding.

NRP PROFESSIONAL DEVELOPMENT AWARD



Who is eligible for the award

- 1. Full or part-time permanent employees at the University of North Carolina at Chapel Hill (SHRA or EHRA non-faculty) or UNC Health who have been employed as a Research Professional for at least the past 1 year at the time of this application are eligible for this award.
- 2. Funding must be for individual benefit, relate to the employee's position, and meet a professional development purpose (not departmental).
- 3. Applicant may not have received the UNC NRP Professional Development Award for the same or a different opportunity in the two years prior to the application.

Note that this award criteria may change in future cycles.

Presentation Overview: ICIMH



- Analyzed dietary supplement and natural product (DSNP) usage among participants with chronic low back pain
 - OPTIMUM: A group-based pain management program for patients with chronic low-back pain modeled on the Mindfulness-Based Stress Reduction Program
- DSNPs marketed and recommended for pain treatment and little known about prevalence of their use in this population
- Collected demographics, type of DSNPs used for chronic pain, prescription medication use, supplement labels

- ICIMH Conference attendance in Cleveland, Ohio
- Strengthened my SAS skills while analyzing data
- Completed my first conference oral presentation!
 - New presentation skills
- Immersion in the integrative medicine space solidified my passion for a career in research at UNC
- Learned about various integrative medicine concepts such as nutrition, neurotechnology, and mindfulness
- Next Steps: Paper writing and publication!

- Obtaining CCRP certification helped with stepping into a research manager role
- I chose the SOCRA CRRP certification because it was more general than the ACRP certifications
 - ACRP (Association of Clinical Research Professionals) certifications seemed to be more specific to roles, but both ACRP and SOCRA are great options
- Study Materials:
 - SOCRA provided CCRP Exam Manual includes FDA regulations on Protection of Human Subjects, IRBs, Investigational New Drug Applications, Investigational Device Exemptions
 - SOCRA recommended Clinical Safety Data Management: Definitions and Standards for Expedited Reporting
 - Prioritize studying based on gaps in knowledge

NRP Award for SOCRA Certification



- Society of Clinical Research Associates (SOCRA) Certification Exam
 - Eligible after working in clinical research for 2 years full time
 - Also qualify if worked part time for 5 years (3,500 hours)
 - Two other categories for qualification
- Highly recommend receiving this credential
 - Valid for 3 years and can renew with 45 hours of continuing education
- Studied exam specifics for ~2 weeks and took exam virtually
- Increased my knowledge of regulatory guidelines, clinical trial design, data management, and adverse event reporting


